The Hamilton Funeral Procession, NYC

- Walking the Route of the Original Procession
- July 14th, Anniversary Date of the Funeral
- Start: John B. & Angelica Church's Home
- Finish: Trinity Church Graveyard

The Museum of American Finance, NYC

- Located at 48 Wall Street
- A Smithsonian Institution Site
- Traces the History of American Finance
- Section Dedicated to Alexander Hamilton

Federal Hall National Memorial

- Located at 26 Wall Street, NYC
- National Park Service Site
- The U.S. Capitol from 1785 to 1790
